






Seal vs Sea Lion

SEALS:

- Ear Holes
- Short, hairy front flippers with long claws
- Hind flippers remain straight; can only move on land by wiggling on belly
- Quiet
- Do not touch each other, except for moms and pups
- Spotted coats can be a variety of shades from white or silver-gray to black or dark brown

SEA LIONS:

- Ear Flaps
- Long, hairless front flippers
- Hind flippers rotate underneath to allow them to walk on land
- Bark a lot – noisy!
- Like to touch each other; very gregarious
- Males have chocolate brown coats; females are a lighter, golden brown
